

## Regulation of the “Gouden Garnaal - Mosselronde”

### Article 1 : Organisation

The “Gouden Garnaal Mossel Ronde” for juniors is organized by Wielervereniging Boekhoute -Oosteeklo in collaboration with Stichting Wielercomité Philippine and will take place -under the regulations of the International Cycling Union and the KNWU on Sunday 16/07/2023. Start at om 02.00 pm in Boekhoutedorp - Boekhoute, and finish at the same place around 05.00 pm, Total distance :115,9 km

### Article 2 : Type of competition and UCI classificaton

The “Gouden Garnaal Mossel Ronde” juniors is classified as a MJ1.1 (European continental tour).

### Article 3 : Participation

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the “Gouden Garnaal Mossel Ronde” is open to UCI national teams, regional teams, clubs and mixed teams. Teams must be formed of minimum 4 and maximum 6 riders, in accordance with article 2.2.003 of the UCI regulations.

### Article 4 : Race Headquarters

De race headquarters will be open at 10.00 am till 6.00 pm, and is located in Dorpshuis, Boekhoutedorp in Boekhoute.

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters participation and to collect their race numbers at the race headquarters on 16/07/2023 between 10.30 am and 11.45 am.

The team managers meeting will be organized according art1.2.087 of the UCI regulations at 12.00 am also in the race headquarters, and this in the presence of the members of the commissaires panel.

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### Article 5 : Neutral technical support

The technical support service is handled by Shimano, and this by 2 cars.

### Article 6 : Antidoping test

Antidoping test will take place in the rooms of the school, situated next to the headquarters. The antidoping regulation of the UCI and KNWU will be applied.

### Article 7 : Radio Tour

Race information will be broadcasted in th following frequency : 155. 9375 Mhz ( channel1). The telecommunications equipment for the cars of the commissaires, the race director, press and invited guests will be made available by KNWU.

### Article 8 : Awards ceremony

According the regulation of the UCI, the first three riders of the “Gouden Garnaal Mossel Ronde” must attend the official awards ceremony at the podium latest 15 minutes after arrival. De winner will receive, next to the money ( see article 9) also a jewel of the “Gouden Garnaal”.

### Article 9 : Prices

#### Individual final standings

1215 euro in total for the individual prices, divided over 20 prizes as followed.

200/150/125/100/90/80/70/60/50/40/5\*30/5\*20 euro

#### Team prices

300 euro in total, divided over 3 prizes as followed

150/100/50 euro

Individual intermediate sprints

300 euro in total divided over 3 prizes as followed

150/100/50 euro

Ranking will be made in the last 5 local laps, and as followed. First rider, 3 points, second rider 2 points and third rider 1 point.

In case of equal points in this ranking, the position in the global ranking will be decisive.

#### Article 10 Environment

The zone where riders can throw away their rubbish (indicated with green panels) is placed at the following location :

0,5 km before till 0,50 km after the provision zone , located in the “Stationsstraat 76 te Boekhoute”.

The employees of the organization will clean up the waste after the passage of the riders.

Feeding is aloud from 30 km after the start till 20 km before the the finish.

#### Article 11 : Changing rooms and showers

Changing rooms and showers are available in the rooms of “Scouts Michiel de Ruyter”, located Vliet 20 A te Boekhoute.
